

Employee Attestation of COVID-19 Vaccination

Under Cal/OSHA's June 17, 2021 revision to the emergency temporary standard (ETS) *Section 3205 COVID-19 Prevention*, all businesses and governmental entities in California are required to determine the COVID-19 vaccination status of their employees (as well as contractors, volunteers, and others who regularly work onsite). In light of this requirement, we are requesting the following vaccination status information from employees.

Please note that you are required to provide accurate information about your vaccination status, or alternatively may decline to provide your vaccination status. If you decline to provide information about your vaccination status, we will be required to assume you are unvaccinated for purposes of rules or requirements in the workplace that are different for vaccinated or unvaccinated employees. For purposes of this certification, you are considered "fully vaccinated" two weeks after completing the second dose of a two-dose COVID-19 vaccine (e.g., Pfizer or Moderna) or two two weeks after receiving a single dose of a one-dose vaccine (e.g., Johnson & Johnson/Janssen).

- I am fully vaccinated.
 - I provided proof of vaccination.
 - I showed proof of vaccination.
 - I self-attested to full vaccination status.

- I have not been vaccinated.

- I decline to answer.
